Your Care Tablet Joint Replacement

This care tablet is provided during your hospital stay to improve your experience and provide education about your expected recovery.



Your nurse will teach you how to use your care tablet when you return from surgery.

If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask your nurse or patient care associate (PCA).

How to use your care tablet.

- After you're settled in, your nurse will bring you a tablet and show you how it works.
- We will provide as much help as you need on how to use the tablet.
- To turn the tablet ON, press the oval button. This button will always take you back to the main home screen. When pressed, it will clear any login information you have entered.
- To turn the tablet OFF, press the button on the top left of the tablet.
- The volume controls are on the top of the tablet.
- The tablet will stay in your room while you are in the hospital.
- If you notice that the battery is running low, please let us know, and we will charge it.

Information you will find on your care tablet.

- Each day you will view a video that describes what to expect during your hospital stay and the healing process.
- You will also find other helpful educational resources such as exercises and videos.
- We will show you how to email the information to yourself so you can refer to it when you get home.
- In the "Welcome to 6 East" section, you'll find the TV guide and room service menu.
- The tablet also contains games, things to read and music to make your stay more comfortable.
- We encourage you to use the tablet to give us feedback. However, please use your call light when you need immediate help.
- We'll also show you how to use our Patient Portal (myHuntingtonHealth.com) where you can access your lab results and discharge information.
