

## **HUNTINGTON HOSPITAL OUTPATIENT REHAB SERVICES**

Huntington Hospital's Outpatient Rehabilitation Services Department is a fully integrated program specializing in neurological, orthopedic, and wound care diagnoses. We emphasize one on one care with a **licensed** professional for our patients. Individual care is unique when compared to many of the outpatient rehab clinics in the area, and we feel this gives the patient the best opportunity for an optimal outcome. All of our services are conveniently located inside the hospital premises on the first floor of the La Vina building (we do not have any satellite or off campus facilities).

### **PHYSICAL THERAPY (PT)**

- ❑ Orthopedic/neurologic diagnoses
- ❑ Wound care/management (Certified Wound Therapist)
- ❑ Lymphedema management (Certified Manual Lymph Drainage Therapist)
- ❑ Vestibular balance disorders (e.g. vertigo, benign paroxysmal positional vertigo)

### **OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY (OT)**

- ❑ Orthopedic/neurologic diagnoses
- ❑ Hand therapy program (Certified Hand Therapist)
  - ❑ Customized splint fabrication
  - ❑ Both non-surgical and post-surgical care available

### **SPEECH THERAPY (SP)**

- ❑ Assessment and treatment of
  - ❑ Speech and language problems
  - ❑ Thinking, processing, and memory difficulties
  - ❑ Voice problems
  - ❑ Swallowing problems

### **NEUROLOGICAL TEAM**

- ❑ A dedicated team of therapists (PT/OT/SP) who treat a variety of neurological diagnoses (e.g. stroke, brain injury) using a well-coordinated team approach. These patients often need all 3 rehab therapy services and thus we make every effort to accommodate an efficient schedule for the patient

### **AUDIOLOGY**

- ❑ Hearing tests and counseling
- ❑ Hearing aid evaluations (HH does not sell hearing aids; patients are referred back to PCP or specialist for equipment)
- ❑ ENG (Electronystagmography) for evaluation of dizziness or balance problems
- ❑ Tympanogram/middle ear analysis
- ❑ Tinnitus counseling

We accept patients with Medicare, Medi-Cal, Worker's Compensation, and most private insurance coverage. A signed prescription is needed from a licensed California physician to initiate treatment.
